Urgent care in Hawaii⁷

If you need urgent care outside of normal business hours, you can visit a Kaiser Permanente or contracted urgent care facility at the same cost of a regular office visit. Visit **kp.org/getcare** for a list of facilities in your area. **Urgent and emergency care outside Hawaii** With Kaiser Permanente, you have coverage for emergency and urgent care anywhere in the world.

If you need urgent care **in a Kaiser Permanente service area**, visiting members can go to the nearest Kaiser Permanente urgent care clinic.⁸

If you need urgent care **in a state without Kaiser Permanente**, go to the nearest urgent care provider, including Cigna PPO Network providers, MinuteClinic® locations, including pharmacies (in select CVS and Target stores), Concentra Urgent Care centers, or The Little Clinic locations, including pharmacies.⁹

Dependent children, including college students, also have coverage for certain routine and followup primary care when Kaiser Permanente facilities aren't near. Visiting member benefits apply when living in other Kaiser Permanente service areas.

If you need urgent care **while traveling internationally**, go to the nearest urgent care facility or hospital.¹⁰

To use the Kaiser Permanente app, you must be a Kaiser Permanente member registered on kp.org. **7.** An urgent care need is one that requires prompt medical attention, usually within 24 or 48 hours, but is not an emergency medical condition. **8.** If you get care at a Cigna, MinuteClinic, Concentra, The Little Clinic, or any other urgent care facility within a state with Kaiser Permanente providers, you'll be asked to pay upfront for services you receive and will need to file a claim for reimbursement. **9.** The Cigna PPO Provider Network refers to the health care providers (doctors, hospitals, specialists) contracted as part of the Cigna PPO for Shared Administration. You can visit any Cigna PPO Network provider without paying upfront or filing a claim for reimbursement. The Cigna PPO Network is not available to HMO and EPO members enrolled in coverage issued by Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of Washington and Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of Washington Options, Inc. If you get care at a MinuteClinic, Concentra, or The Little Clinic urgent care center, you'll be charged your standard copay or coinsurance. Medicaid members are not eligible. **10.** You may be covered for medically necessary urgent care when you are temporarily outside of the country if the care can't be delayed until you get back home. Medicaid members are not covered.


